DM Relay and DM Long Distance September 10th to 11th 2022 at Slotslyngen and Paradisbakkerne, Bornholm

The event begins with DM Relay on Saturday September 10th and ends with DM Long on Sunday September 11th.

DM-weekend on Bornholm:

- Two intense competitions in fantastic terrains.
- Newly drawn maps (2021-22) by GT-Maps.
- DM Long is an IOF World Ranking Event (WRE) and part of Trimtex Cup, Løberen League and the Danish Junior Cup.
- Open courses at all levels of difficulty are offered both days in the same competition areas as the championship courses.
- Free children's courses close to the arenas are offered on both days.

Terrain description

Slotslyngen

Slotslyngen is a moderate to strong hilly forest with mixed vegetation and few flat, more diffuse parts. Parts of the forest are on rocky ground and with rock walls. There are areas with easily passable forest and a few dense areas. In other areas, runners will experience dense undergrowth and parts with blueberries. There is a large heather / grass covered area with a complex density image.

Paradisbakkerne

Paradisbakkerne were formerly covered with heather, but today most of the area is forest with deciduous and coniferous trees. It is a very varied terrain with strong hilly areas, long fissure valleys, but also flat areas in some parts of the forest. Some areas are rocky with rock walls, large rocks and rocky ground, while the forest floor in other areas is covered with blueberries and tall grass.

The runnability is generally good with few denser areas. However, visibility is reduced in several places.

The path picture is poor in several areas of the forest and consists of a few larger paths and smaller tracks.

Slotslyngen, 1:10.000 and 1:7.500.

Contour interval 5 meters.

Seeding of runners will take place in the elite classes in accordance with DOF Regulation 2021 and the IOF World Ranking List.

Open courses

Open Courses are offered both days in the same competition area as the championship courses. Participation in an Open Course is not allowed prior to participation in a championship course.

Distances

Slotslyngen

Parking to Event Centre: 1.200 to 1.700 m.

Start and finish in the Event Centre.

Start open courses is in the immediate vicinity of the Event Centre.

Paradisbakkerne

Parking to Event Centre: 400 to 800 m.

Event Centre to Start 1: 1.200m. Event Centre to Start 2: 500m.

Open courses are starting from Start 2.

Finish in the Event Centre.

Parking and meeting point

Slotslyngen

At Bornholms Tekniske Samling, Borrelyngvej 48 and if this is filled on Borrelyngvej 41.

Parking for busses in the courtyard at Borrelyngvej 41.

Paradisbakkerne

At the roadside on Klintebyvej. Busses will be parked in a courtyard on Klintebyvej.

Any clubs arriving by bus are asked to give preliminary notice to the event's e-mail (see below).

Arenas

Slotslyngen

The arena is small and situated on rocky ground with much growth of blackberries in the area. If weather permits, we recommend leaving the club tent at home on this day. Event office placed at arena.

Paradisbakkerne

The arena is on a sloping grass field. Event office placed at arena.

Entry

Entry for DM Relay and DM Long for members of Danish clubs through club administrator by O-service. Deadline Friday 26 August 2022. Late entry allowed until 96 hours before first start. After that, participants are referred to the open courses.

Entry for **DM Long in WRE classes W21/M21 MUST use IOF Eventor**. This applies for both Danish and international participants.

Entry for **international participants** except WRE-participants in DM Long through the event's e-mail (see below) and payments made to the bank account named below. Entries must include name, age, class, SI-card number, club and country and for relay teams also the start order.

Entry for DM Relay for international participants team-wise by sending an e-mail (see below) and payment for the entire team by the account mentioned below.

Entry in advance for open courses can be made by e-mail until 2 September 2022.

Entry without SI-card number will be provided a rental SI-card (not touch free) at an additional fee.

Team changes DM Relay

A relay team's member names and start order can be changed by the club administrator through O-service or e-mail for international participants until Thursday 7 September at 24:00. Following that, changes can be made until 8:00 on the day of the event by paying an extra fee of 50 DKK per team for each time a change is made.

Changes and late entrees can be made by sending an e-mail to dm22@sollerodok.dk. or delivering to the Event Centre Office. The extra fee must be paid at the event office on the day of the event.

Entries must include name, age, class, SI-card number, club and country and for relay teams also the start order.

Participants

Every member of a club under DOF (Danish Orienteering Federation) or IOF on the day of the competition is granted access to the competition classes.

Prizes

Prizes in the Danish Championships can be won by participants who are members of a Danish club under the Danish Orienteering Federation and are 1) Danish citizens or 2) have a Danish CPR-number on the day of competition. All members of a relay team must fulfil these rules.

Punching system

The competition will use SportIdent. Controls have SI devices which support both traditional and touch-free cards.

Runners using their own SI-card must provide the SI-card number at the time of entry.

Entry without SI-card number will be provided a rental SI-card (not touch free). Rental SI-cards will be handed out at the start and must be returned at the finish.

Missing return of a rental card costs DKK 500.

Start DM Relay

Joint start per class.

First class starts 10:30.

Start from Event Centre for Sprint Relay.

Start Open courses in the immediate vicinity of the event centre.

DM Long

Individual start.

First class starts at 10.00.
